What two powers within Federalism are related to the State of Missouri?

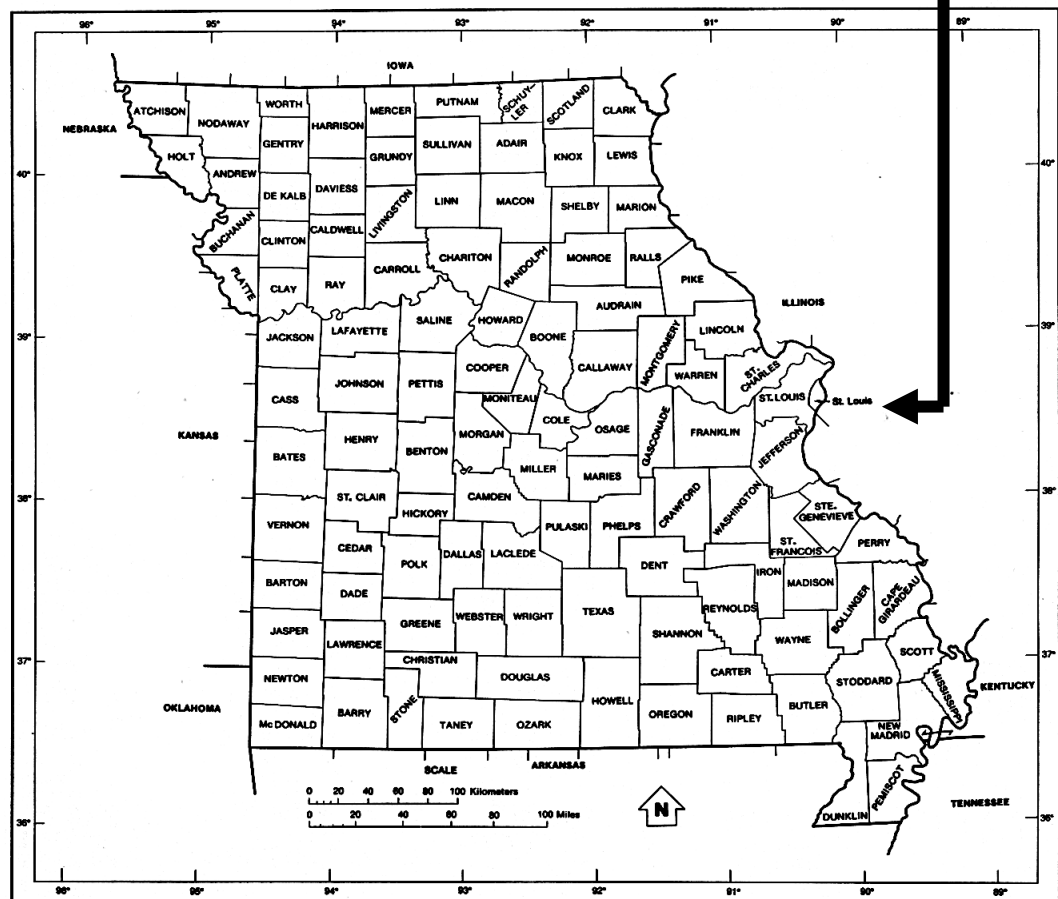
